At The Collingwood Brewery, the community is celebrated. In addition to Downhill, the brewery produces five more core beers, including flavour-packed lagers to IPAs, that have become its signature.

Side Launch Brewing Company

Named in recognition of Collingwood's ship-building history, Side Launch opened its doors with 27,000 square feet of brewing space in 2014 and has grown from 4 beers to 5 Core LCBO beers, rotating LCBO seasonal beers and countless small batch beers only available in the taproom and online. The brewery's focus is on traditional German styles, and all of its beer uses Collingwood water, filtered through the inhouse filtration system, a blend of imported and domestic malts, and European and North American hops.
